STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Kules:

Under Stage I Fire Restrictions, the following activities are prohibited: 1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire or campfire except within a developed recreation site or improved site. 2. Smoking is prohibited, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, or a developed and a resolution is adopted rescinding these rules. recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials. The rules will remain in effect until there is a change in fire danger

agency. An exemption stated above does not absolve an individual or organization from liability town or city boundary are exempted. 6. All lands subject to jurisdiction of a separate government organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty. 5. All lands within a appropriate land management agency. 4. Violation Penalties:

Any person or persons violating these Stage I Fire Restrictions set forth herein may be fined up to \$5,000 individually, or \$10,000 for an organization; and imprisoned up to six (6) months for violating such restrictions and closures.
