

RESOLUTION 2024-4

A GRANITE COUNTY RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A STUDY COMMISSION ELECTION AS A BALLOT ISSUE ON THE PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT ON TUESDAY, JUNE 4, 2024

WHEREAS, Montana Constitution Article XI, Section 9 (1972), and Montana Code Annotated Section 7-3-173(2) (2023), require local governments in Montana to call for and hold study commission elections before the respective local government's electorate every ten (10) years; and,

WHEREAS, the last study commission election for Granite County, Montana was held in 2014; and,

WHEREAS, the study commission may not cost more than \$12,000, and if the electorate votes in favor of such a study commission consist of three (3) members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Granite County Commissioners hereby calls and establishes a local government study commission election to be held as a ballot issue placed on the Primary Election Ballot in Granite County, Montana, on Tuesday, June 4, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study commission ballot issue language shall be as follows:

[] FOR the review of the government of Granite County and the establishment and funding, not to exceed twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000), of a local government study commission consisting of three (3) members of the public to examine the government of Granite County and submit recommendations on the government.

[] AGAINST the review of the government of Granite County and the establishment and funding, not to exceed twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000), of a local government study commission consisting of three (3) members of the public to examine the government of Granite County and submit recommendations on the government.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this Resolution shall have an immediate effective date.

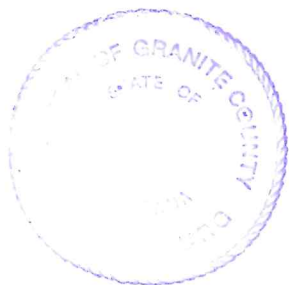
